

Week 17 Modified Chapman Format: Alternate Shot

The signup sheets are in the A Flight Blue Binder

This week's tournament is a 2-man team event. Remember that your team needs to play with one or more club members and someone needs to attest the scorecard.

This event is not flighted. We will pay the top eight places for all teams.

This event is handicapped from the **gold** tees. You will record your **net team score in the A Flight book**.

We are still playing lift, clean and place in your own fairway. Lift, rake and place in the traps. In rough if it is ground under repair, you can take a drop no closer to the hole. There are no gimme putts. All holes must be finished in the cup.

Everyone plays from the gold tees.

Enter both names and gold handicaps and one team handicap on the score sheet in the binder. Your Team Handicap is both handicaps from the gold tees added together and divided by 2 (round down, if necessary, 12.5 is a 12). We are using 100% handicaps. There is no minimum difference between team member handicaps in this tournament.

When you are finished, enter one net score for the team on the score sheet in the A Flight binder. Put your signed card in the tournament mailbox.

Our Modified Chapman Format: (so you are hitting more shots)

1. Both Players tee off.
2. You then hit each other's drive for your second shot.
3. Pick the better of the two second shots.
4. Play alternate shot the rest of the way in.
5. Record the gross and net score based on handicap from the golds on the scorecard.

For example – my partner is Tim.

1. We both tee off and hit about 200 yards.
2. For a second shot, I hit Tim's drive into the left rough. Tim hits my drive on the green.
3. We choose my drive and Tim's second shot and we play the next shot from there

4. Since Tim hit it on the green, I putt first. I miss the putt, so Tim putts next. If he misses (which he won't) then I would putt again.

5. Record the gross and **net** team score on the scorecard since this a handicap tournament

There is no minimum tee shots required for each teammate.

Do NOT enter this score in your GHIN account.
